At this meeting, the Governing Board (Board) will have the opportunity to learn about updates regarding the most recent Community Engagement Advisory Board (Advisory Board) meeting.

Requested Action:

There is no requested action for this item. This is an informational item only.

Board members will have the opportunity to vote on the Community Engagement proposal at the May 2024 Board meeting after having undergone a feasibility study; as such, it is requested that Board members not discuss this topic at this time.

Summary:

The <u>Governance Manual</u> states, "At the fall Advisory Board meeting, up to three proposals that were prioritized in the pre-meeting survey will be considered. The Advisory Board member who submitted the proposal will present it to the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board will discuss and be asked to vote on whether the proposal should be advanced to the Office, so that it can conduct a feasibility study" (page 36).

In preparation for the discussion of proposals, the Office of Cradle-to-Career Data (Office) provided a <u>presentation</u> on the recommendation process and detailed the work included in the feasibility study, including data, cost, and compliance considerations, as well as data collections methodologies. In total, the Office received one proposal, and therefore Advisory Board members did not need to fill out a pre-meeting survey. The <u>recommendation</u> <u>was from Advisory Board Member Curry-Nuñez</u>, and Advisory Board members voted to advance this recommendation to the feasibility study stage.

Advisory Board members will next meet on Wednesday, March 20, 2024 where the Office will share the findings of the feasibility studies and members will determine if the proposal should advance to the Board. If the proposal formally advances to the Board, this will be agendized and discussed for the May 1, 2024 Board meeting.
