

2023 Community Engagement Advisory Board Candidates Finalized

Given the impending vacancies, the Community Engagement member composition will include three advocacy members, three community members, and four practitioners. Advocacy members represent The Education Trust-West, Immigrants Rising, and Public Advocates. Community members represent Northern California College Promise Coalition, Southern California College Access Network, and LA Promise Fund. And four practitioners represent K-12, with one practitioner representing UC.

Below are the top applicants as well as alternates based on member scoring. Areas that are gray are choice points for the Committee. A final determination will be made by the Committee and then will be recommended to the Governing Board for approval.
