At this meeting, the Governing Board (Board) will have the opportunity to elect a new Chair Elect.

Requested Action:

After review and consideration of the statement of interest submitted by a fellow Board member, Staff recommends that the Board vote to elect a new Chair Elect.

Move to approve Gavin Payne for Chair Elect of the Board.

Background:

Amy Fong, current Chair of the Board will be transitioning out of leadership and Robert Tagorada, will become the new Chair of the Board. Given this transition, there will be a vacancy in the Chair Elect position.

The Governance Manual states that the Board will elect a Chair to serve two-year staggered terms. In the first year of the term, the newly elected Chair Elect will support the existing Presiding Chair. In the second year of the term, the Chair Elect will become the Presiding Chair. The Chair Elect and the Presiding Chair may not be from the same institution. All eligible board members who are interested in serving as the Chair Elect will submit a statement of interest for discussion and a vote at the first Governing Board meeting of each fiscal year.

The Office received one statement of interest, which can be found in Attachment A.

Responsibilities of the Chair Elect:

The Chair Elect will be responsible for convening topical committees for tasks such as appointing Advisory Board members, onboarding new Board members, conducting exit interviews with outgoing Board members, and working with the Office to onboard new Advisory Board members.

Gavin Payne Candidate Statement: Board Chair-Elect

As we know, with Cradle-to-Career, California is creating a best-in-class public system that harnesses data from throughout the state. Currently, I sit on the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards as well as the C2C Board. I served previous stints on the boards of the California Teachers Retirement System, the Newt Elder Education Foundation, WestEd, and Heath House.
