Subject:	Changes to Data Points in the P20W Data Set

At this meeting, the Governing Board (Board) will have the opportunity to hear updates about potential changes to data points in the P20W data system.

Requested Action:

For this item, the Office of Cradle to Career Data (Office) recommends the Board consider the proposed changes in context of the limitations and implications described.

Motion 1: Move to approve the addition of data points to the P20W data set and moving data points from one data partner to another.
Motion 2: Move to approve the data points that would be removed from the P20W data set.

Background:

This memo outlines the data that the Office received in its first data submission from its partners in October 2023. The resource in the appendix highlights a summary of data points:

- a) Received in Oct. 2023 (see Appendix)
- b) Additional data for future submissions (Motion 1)
- c) Provided by a different department (Motion 1)
- d) Not received in Oct. 2023 and the Data Provider does not expect to provide the data in the future (Motion 2)
- e) Not received in Oct. 2023, but planned for future submissions
- f) Would need to be submitted by a different Data Provider in the future and options have been identified

This memo describes specific context about these data points to inform the Board's decision making.

For more context, please review pages 29-31 of the <u>Governance Manual</u>, which describes the process that is taken when a Data Provider wishes to formally add, remove, or reassign data points to the list of P20W data points.

Note that file specifications may reflect multiple data elements per data point named in the participation agreement. In many cases, Data Providers shared multiple data elements to ensure the Office has the full analytic picture for an associated data point. For example, the California Department of Education (CDE) shared data elements like course identification codes and term codes associated with the math courses data points.

Additional data points that will be submitted (Action: Motion 1):

The Department of Social Services (DSS) will expand the information it is providing to include the following data points:

- Sex/Gender (DSS)
- Race/Ethnicity (DSS)
- Child with a Disability (including IEP Status) (DSS)

Data points that will be provided by a different department (Action: Motion 1): In two cases, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) does not have a data point, but DSS does, so both entities are requesting that the data points be moved from DHCS's list and added to DSS's list in the P20W data set:

- Foster Youth (DSS)
- Early Learning and Care Primary Language (DSS)

Data points Data Providers do not expect to submit in the future (Action: Motion 2):

Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender (LGBT) Status (CSAC and DHCS): <u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> Neither the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) nor DHCS collect this data point, and both entities are requesting that it be removed from their list of data points in the P20W data set.

<u>Office Analysis:</u> During the planning process, information on sexual orientation and gender identity was identified as an area where data collection norms and processes are evolving. Currently, the California Community Colleges (CCC) is the only entity that provides data on LGBT status for the P20W data set.

Race/Ethnicity (CSAC):

<u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> CSAC receives its race/ethnicity data directly from CDE, and is requesting that it be removed from their list of data points in the P20W data set.

<u>Office Analysis:</u> The P20W data set already includes race/ethnicity information from CDE. Additionally, race/ethnicity information also comes from CCC, California State University (CSU), University of California (UC), DHCS, and now DSS.

Standardized Exam Scores (IB, AP, ACT, SAT) (CDE):

<u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> CDE has noted that it cannot disclose these data points, but that C2C could obtain the data directly from the entities that administer the exams.

Office Analysis: During the planning process, CDE clarified that this information could only be shared if an additional data sharing agreement were secured with the entities that administer the standardized exams. According to a 2017 survey, the National Center for Education Statistics noted that 65 percent of the 46 states and territories surveyed had college-readiness test scores operational in their state's longitudinal data system. 11 percent are in the progress of including these data and 7 percent are planning to (Bloom-Weltman, 2019, pg. 21). Given the number of other states including standardized test scores in their longitudinal data systems, the Office has submitted inquiries to College Board, ACT, and International Baccalaureate (IB) to explore procedures for requesting data from these organizations.

Parental Education Level (CDE):

<u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> The CDE is providing a socioeconomic status (SES) indicator to the P20W data system, which is calculated by combining several data points, including parental education level and whether students are receiving or are eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Meals (FRPM). CDE noted that if the Parental Education level is also provided, it could inadvertently disclose whether students are receiving or are eligible for FRPM. The CDE states that it is prohibited by federal statute, Section 9(b)(6)(A) of the National School Lunch Act (42 USC 1758(b)(6)(A)), from providing FRPM data on students for purposes other than providing students with school breakfast or lunch without parental consent.

Office analysis: The P20W data set includes parental education information from CCC, CSU, and UC. However, absent data from CDE, information would not be available for students who do not enter postsecondary education. Furthermore, given pending new guidance from the federal government related to changes to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), CSAC—which currently provides information on parental education—may no longer be able to do so. Given this context, removing parental education level from the data points submitted by CDE would leave a gap in information.

Not received in Oct. 2023, but planned for future submissions (No action requested):

Early Education and Care Data (CDE):

Per the Participation Agreement, "California Department of Education (CDE) Early Learning and Care (ELC) Data to be provided by the CDE until DSS houses the data." DSS and CDE are working on systems for collecting these data points within their agencies, DSS through their Early Childhood Integration Data System (ECIDS) and CDE through a system for California State Preschool data. The Office will continue to work with entities to include this domain in the data system.

Average Class Size by Grade (CDE):

CDE noted that new legislation will change the file structure and that this data point should be postponed for now. Senate Bill 872 (Chapter 614, Statutes of 2023) added Education Code 33317.5, requiring the CDE to publish a report on class size. The requirements in the statute will change the file structure of the existing CDE report on DataQuest for "Average Class Size by Subject".

Data points that would need to be submitted by a different Data Provider in the future and options have been identified (No action requested):

Homeless Status (DHCS):

<u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> DHCS does not have a validated flag for homelessness, requests to remove the data point from its list, and has identified an alternate source for the information.

Office Analysis: The ability to disaggregate data visualizations by homelessness status was an important priority documented in the planned data dashboards during the planning process. The P20W data set contains homelessness information from CDE, CCC, and CSAC. However, absent information from DHCS, information would not be available for students who do not enroll in postsecondary after high school. To fill these gaps, the Office can work with DHCS to identify whether information could be provided by other California Health and Human Services (CalHHS) departments or by the Homelessness Data Information System.

Postsecondary Students Receiving Disability Services (DHCS):

<u>Context from the Data Provider:</u> DHCS does not collect the postsecondary status of students receiving disability services, requests to remove the data point from its list, and has identified an alternate source for the information.

<u>Office Analysis:</u> The ability to disaggregate data visualizations by disability status was an objective identified during the planning process. Currently, the P20W data set includes a data point on "child with a disability (IEP status)" from CDE and "postsecondary student receiving disability services" from CCC. The Office is working with CalHHS to discuss the possibility of securing information on disability status from DSS.
