Enrollment:

- 184,000 undergraduate students (20% of undergrads)
- 166,000 graduate students (54% of graduate students)
- 18% of undergrads are nontraditional learners

Commitment to student success

- 66% four-year graduation rate
- 77% six-year graduation rate
- 75% of AICCU institutions are HSI or emerging HIS
- 78% of AICCU institutions are Yellow Ribbon Institutions



Breaking Down Myths

Reflecting California's diversity:

- 66% of undergrads are of non-White backgrounds
- 82% of Cal Grant recipients are of non-White backgrounds, including 51% of Latino background
- 77% of Pell Grant recipients are of non-White backgrounds, including 41% of Latino background

Making higher ed affordable

- 79% of UG receive aid of some sort
- Over 25,000 Cal Grant students
- Over 46,000 Pell Grant students
- Average institutional aid to CG recipient: \$24,000

- 39% of newly credentialed teachers (37% enrolled)
- 51% of nursing degrees
- 91% of clinical, counseling, and applied psychology degrees
- 95% of physician assistant graduates
