At this meeting, the Community Engagement Advisory Board Ad Hoc Committee for Proposal Prioritization (Ad Hoc Committee) will have the opportunity to review the key components of the proposal prioritization process as well as key milestones in the process.

Requested Action:

There is no requested action for this item. This is an informational item only.

Background:

The <u>Governance Manual</u> states that "at the summer meeting, members will also determine if they would like to form an Ad Hoc Committee of up to five members who will convene publicly and be charged with writing a report with the recommended prioritization of the proposal forms received. The report will be due and posted on the Cradle to Career Data's (C2C) website at least one week prior to the pre-meeting survey."

At the July 10, 2024 Data and Tools and Community Engagement joint Advisory Boards meeting, the Community Engagement Advisory Board <u>established the Ad Hoc Committee</u>. This included the approval of a charter, Attachment A, and allowed for five Community Engagement members to volunteer to be a part of

the Ad Hoc Committee. The charter sets forth the purpose, duration, scope of work, and activities of the Committee.

Among other activities outlined in the charter, the Ad Hoc Committee will:

- Publicly discuss the weaknesses and strengths of proposals submitted by Community Engagement Advisory Board members and narrowing in on a top three;
- Review and approve the draft report with a top three prioritization and reasoning.

August 22, 2024 Ad Hoc Committee Meeting One:

In this meeting, the Ad Hoc Committee will:

- Discuss the proposals submitted by the Community Engagement Advisory Board members, prioritize top three proposals, and provide clear reasoning.
- Two Ad Hoc Committee members will be chosen to work offline to draft the report with a top three prioritization and reasoning based off of the deliberation that takes place at the Ad Hoc Committee meeting.

September 4, 2024 Ad Hoc Committee Meeting Two:

In this meeting, the Ad Hoc Committee will:

 Review the draft report with a top three prioritization and reasoning, deliberate, make any necessary revisions, and approve the report.



2024 Community Engagement Ad Hoc Committee for Proposal Prioritization Charter

Purpose:

The 2024 Community Engagement Ad Hoc Committee for Proposal Prioritization (Ad Hoc Committee) shall assist the Community Engagement Advisory Board (CEAB) by convening in public meetings to discuss and draft a report with a top three recommended prioritization of the proposal forms submitted by CEAB members. The report will be due and posted on the Cradle-to-Career Data (C2C) website at least one week prior to the pre-meeting survey. CEAB members can choose to utilize the report drafted by the Ad Hoc Committee as a resource as they individually complete the proposal prioritization process.

Duration:

This will be a short-term Ad Hoc Committee that will sunset after the report is due and posted on the C2C website.

Membership:

The Ad Hoc Committee shall consist of up to five CEAB members. The Ad Hoc Committee cannot convene if it consists of less than three CEAB members.

Scope of Work:

The Ad Hoc Committee would be tasked with drafting a report noting the top three proposals that the Ad Hoc Committee consider to be priorities, along with reasoning for the selection. Other activities may include:

- Publicly discussing the weaknesses and strengths of proposals submitted by CEAB members and narrowing in on a top three;
- As there is not enough time to draft the report with a top three
 prioritization and reasoning in a public session, two members of the Ad
 Hoc Committee will be tasked with this effort. The report will be drafted
 offline by two Ad Hoc Committee members and the content will be

- based off of the decisions made by the Ad Hoc Committee that took place during the public meeting;
- In the second Ad Hoc Committee meeting, the Ad Hoc Committee will review and approve the draft report;
- The final report will be due and posted on the C2C website at least one week prior to the pre-meeting survey.

Activities and Proposed Schedule:

The activities and proposed schedule for the Ad Hoc Committee is as follows:

- July 10, 2024: At the summer joint Advisory Board meeting, CEAB members will determine if they would like to form an Ad Hoc Committee of up to five members.
- August 22, 2024: Ad Hoc Committee members will convene in a public meeting to publicly discuss the recommendations received from the public and will prioritize the top three proposals and reasoning at this first meeting. Two Ad Hoc Committee members will be chosen to work offline to draft the report based off of the deliberation that takes place at the Ad Hoc Committee meeting.
- <u>September 4, 2024</u>: Ad Hoc Committee members will convene for a second public meeting to review the draft report, deliberate, make any necessary revisions, and approve the report.
- <u>September 6, 2024</u>: Draft report with the Ad Hoc Committee's recommended prioritization of the proposal forms due to the Office from the Ad Hoc Committee.

Review:

This information sheet captures information about the Ad Hoc Committee and its creation. The Ad Hoc Committee retains operational flexibility in completing its scope of work and may introduce updates as needed during the review process.
