



## FAQs from the July 10, 2024 Joint Advisory Board Meeting

At the Office of Cradle-to-Career Data, we value engagement with the community as an essential part of building California's first cradle-to-career longitudinal data system. Conversations in the community are as much about clarifying questions as they are about sharing information.

What follows are responses to frequently asked questions the Office receives about P20W data points. Many of these came from our Joint Community Engagement and Data and Tools Advisory Boards meeting on July 10, 2024. Watch a recording of the meeting and view meeting materials [here](#).

As the data system develops and as our conversations continue, we will update this document so you have the most up-to-date information available. We hope this is useful as the members of our Data and Tools Advisory Board consider proposals for the development of the Cradle-to-Career Data System this summer.

### **Where can I view the description of the data points that C2C will provide? Is the list available by data provider?**

### **How many Association of Independent California Colleges and Universities (AICCU) colleges are participating and what type of data will be shared?**

There are currently 14 AICCU member institutions participating. The type of data that will be shared is about California public high school students who attended a participating AICCU member institution.

**Will K-12 student data be linked between the courses the students take and the teachers who teach those courses?**

Not at this time. The data is collected at different times throughout the year and are not aligned.

**What type of data points will be shared for the Teacher Training and Retention Dashboard?**

The Teacher Training and Retention Dashboard will provide information on teacher workforce trends including training pipelines, teacher employment and retention, and employment trends for former teachers. This data set will provide critical information to the public and policymakers to understand and address the shortage of teachers, as well as show patterns of teacher diversity and mobility statewide.

**Will the data system have data on incarcerated students/adults?**

These data points are not included in the P20W system at this time.

**What type of data will be provided on dual enrollment?**

The California Department of Education provides data about whether or not students complete dual enrollment (when a student receives credit from the high school and from the college.) However, not all school districts report this information.

**What type of information will be available for MediCal, CalFresh, and CalWORKS?**

The data system will provide participation information on [MediCal status](#) (California's Medicaid healthcare program), [Cal Fresh status](#) (California's nutrition program that helps households buy healthy foods), and [CalWORKS status](#) (California's public assistance program that provides aid and services to eligible families with children).
