

## RESOLUTION NO. 25-05 APPROVAL OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO C2C'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

November 14, 2025

WHEREAS, the Office of Cradle-to-Career Data is established pursuant to Education Code section 10862 to serve as a neutral administrative body of the California Cradle-to-Career Data System to establish and maintain a longitudinal data system that provides a source for actionable data and research on education, economic, and health outcomes for individuals, families, and communities, and provide for expanded access to tools and services that support the navigation of the education-to-employment pipeline, and under the direction of the Governing Board established pursuant to Education Code section 10864;

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act and its implementing regulations require that all state agencies and departments adopt a Conflict of Interest Code that identifies individuals affiliated with the agency or department that are required to complete the Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) and what types of interests must be disclosed;

WHEREAS, the Conflict of Interest Code (COI Code) was adopted by the Governing Board on May 1, 2024;

WHEREAS, Cradle-to-Career Data System staff proposed amendments to the COI Code, and subsequently made available for public comment the Conflict of Interest code for 45 days, mailed the proposed code to all affected individuals, and received no public comments; and

WHEREAS, the Cradle-to-Career Data System Governing Board is authorized pursuant to Education Code section 10866(d)(7) to adopt regulations, including Amendments to existing regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Cradle-to-Career Data System as follows:

Section 1. The proposed amendments to Cradle-to-Career's Conflict of Interest Code are hereby approved in substantially the form presented on this date.

Section 2. The Executive Director is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of the Governing Board, to submit such regulations, with any and all required supporting documentation, to the Fair Political Practices Commission and the Office of Administrative Law and proceed as required under the Administrative Procedures Act.

Section 3. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute and deliver any documents and take any steps that the Executive Director may deem necessary or advisable in order to effectuate the purposes of this resolution, including making any nonsubstantive changes requested by the Fair Political Practices Commission or the Office of Administrative Law.
